## **BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

At Wednesday night's (5/17) board meeting, the board elected three new trustees. We welcome Sangeeta Chopra, Nikki Cook, and Kevin Fischer to the Board of Trustees. The board is grateful for their service and looks forward to their contributions to our school community.

The board discussed a new board policy regarding the Financial Delegation of Authority Policy and reviewed existing board policies with an eye to necessary updates and revisions. This work will continue through May and should be approved by the June 2017 meeting. The board discussed additional financial aid and approved a new team charter to examine the equitable distribution of tuition discounts in keeping with our mission. The charter group will convene to evaluate our policies and

recommend possible revisions for SY 2018-2019. The board received an update from the facilities committee, namely their work to develop of an offer to purchase 1.8 acres from our neighbor Smith Root, Inc. The facilities committee also reported their efforts to resolve our space constraints for next year. The solutions include a semi-permanent yurt, a temporary portable, or possible renovation of the barn on Smith Root's current property should a purchase be successful.

`The Head of School also reported the untimely death of one of our compressors. Next week is slated to be warm; he is working to resolve this problem as soon as possible. Finally, the board heard from the Head of School regarding his recommendations for the annual assignment of the Ye-Marso Family Volunteerism award which honors family service to the school that has exceeded all expectations.

Finally, the board has elected to conduct a limited search for an interim head. We hope to have a new Head of School in place within the next three to four weeks. We are reaching out to trusted advisors who have recommended a few candidates and beginning our search.

Our last meeting for the year will take place in the farmhouse on 6/21/2017 at 6:00 PM. All are welcome to attend.
